Challenges continue with the construction progress on Glen Road. The City is looking to hold the contractor accountable / penalize or possibly restrict the contractor from future contracts with the City as a result of the challenges on this contract.

As of December 4, 2019, the contractor has committed to complete the east side of Glen Road from Highland Avenue to Summerhill Avenue and to open both lanes of traffic by December 20.

Work on Glen Road will re-start the week of April 6 and be completed in June 2020. Construction Update #5 will be distributed before work re-starts in April.

By December 20 the contractor will:

- Complete the road reconstruction on the east side of Glen Road from Highland Avenue to Summerhill Avenue.
- Backfill excavations and place temporary asphalt for the winter break.
- Open both lanes of traffic and remove construction materials and equipment from the site.

From April 6 to June 30, 2020 the contractor will:

- Complete the road reconstruction on the west side of Glen Road from Beaumont Road to Summerhill Avenue and north of Summerhill Avenue.
- Restore driveways and green areas affected by construction.
