## Bridge Rehabilitation Islington Avenue over Humber River



In June 2019, the City started to rehabilitate the Islington Avenue Bridge over the Humber River, between Fordwich Crescent and Barker Avenue.

Transportation Services, Toronto Hydro and Bell have requested additional work. As such, the end date for this work has been extended to September 2020. Only limited work will continue through the winter due to cold weather, and the majority of construction will re-start in Spring 2020.

## WORK DETAILS

To date, the following work has been completed:

- Removed surface asphalt and parapet wall on the east side of the bridge
- Reconstructed parapet wall on the east side of the bridge
- Removed deteriorated concrete from the abutment and pier faces
- Coated the steel girders

In the coming months, the City's contractor will:

- Reconstruct west parapet wall
- Patch repair the concrete deck soffit, both concrete sidewalks, abutments and pier
- Replace the bridge expansion joints, asphalt surface and waterproofing
- Improve the road drainage and bridge approaches
- Install Bell ducts
