Duncan Creek Restoration

Contract: 19ECS-LU-04SM Expected Start Date: July 2020 Expected End Date: July 2021

The City of Toronto plans to restore Duncan Creek to improve public safety and protect municipal infrastructure against the hazards of stream erosion.

The contractor will construct an engineered natural channel and re-install a recreational pathway. The construction will take place in two phases. The first phase will start approximately 70m upstream of the pedestrian bridge off of Cliffwood Road to approximately 500m upstream of the confluence at Duncan Creek and German Mills Creek. The second phase will start at the source outfall located at Wellesbourne Park to approximately 70m upstream of the pedestrian bridge off of Cliffwood Road.

This project is part of the Council-Approved 2019 Capital Works Program and the City's stormwater infrastructure improvement program that will improve water quality in Duncan Creek.

Pre-Construction Notice

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before construction begins with more information about the work.



Access to Your Home: The City-hired contractor may need access to your home to complete a pre-construction survey. Affected properties will receive a pre-construction survey request to schedule a time to complete the survey.

Tree Removal: due to the nature of this project, the City will have to remove approximately 1100 trees within the creek corridor. Tree removal permits have been obtained in coordination with the City's Parks, Recreation & Forestry Division. Trees removed for the project will be replaced using a replacement ratio of three trees planted for every one tree removed.
