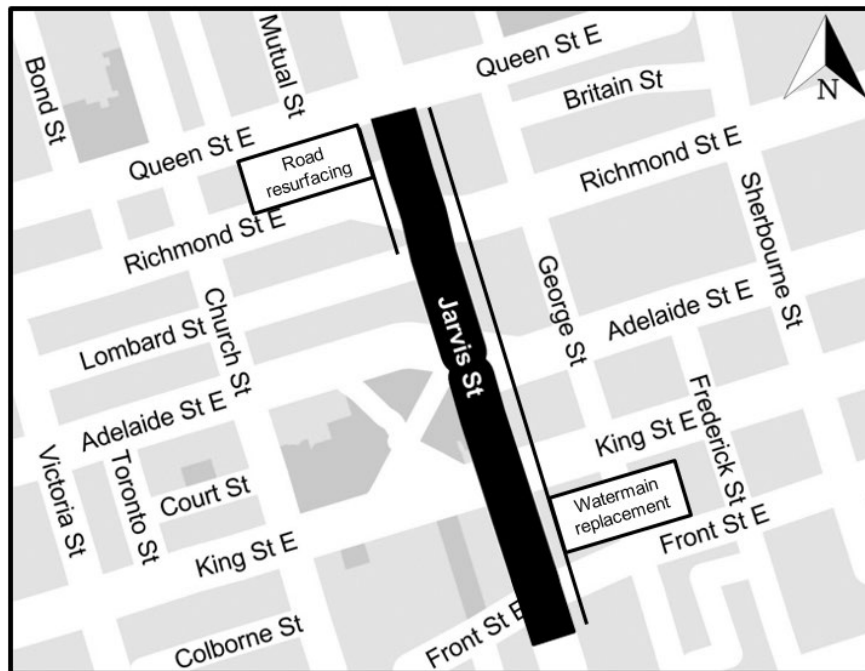

In November, the City of Toronto started replacing the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Jarvis Street from Queen Street East to Front Street East. The remaining work will be completed in 2020.

The road will be temporarily restored to a safe condition and lanes will re-open during the winter break.

To date the City's contractor has partially completed the watermain replacement from King Street East to Queen Street East.
