The Information & Technology (I&T) Division provides leadership for the planning, development and management of the City's information technology systems. The I&T Division partners with all City divisions to deliver business IT solutions for City programs and services and manages the overall investment in IT, optimizing and ensuring alignment with business objectives.

Key enterprise solutions at the City include the City's website (toronto.ca) and key public-facing online services for residents, businesses and visitors of Toronto. Examples include: 311 Toronto, Well Being Toronto, Recreation programs, Parking Permits, Business and Development, Permits and Licensing, Transportation and Roads, to name a few. Internal to the City, the I&T Division also supports the City's corporate financial and human resources solutions as well as the City's IT infrastructure, including the network, data centres, and over 25,000 desktop computers, tablets, notebooks and multi-function printers.
