Contract: 18ECS-TI-19LR



On April 13, following the winter break, work on Glen Road will re-start, weather permitting.

Construction delays: Recent delays on this project are a result of the contractor's shortage of workers deployed to this project in 2019. The City will impose contractual penalties to hold the contractor accountable for the delays. The City of Toronto will not incur any additional costs as a result of these delays.

REMAINING WORK

From April 13 to May 31, 2020 the contractor will:

- Complete road reconstruction on the west side from Beaumont Road to Summerhill Avenue
- Only the northbound lane of traffic will remain open

From June 1 to July 31, 2020 the contractor will:

- Complete road reconstruction from Summerhill Avenue to the north end.
- Only the northbound lane of traffic will remain open.

Restoration of all driveways and green areas will be finalized during the month of August.
