TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTIONS

Sheppard Avenue West between Oakdale Road and Laura Road

Contract: 18ECS-LU-08FP Start Date: Monday, March 2, 2020 End Date: Friday, July 31, 2020 *Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary sewer system in your area in order to reduce surface and basement flooding. Due to the depth and nature of the storm sewer construction work there will be lane restrictions on Sheppard Avenue West until July 31, 2020.


Motorists are reminded to abide by traffic/construction signs posted in local areas to ensure the safety of all road users, pedestrians and cyclists. This project is part of the Council-approved 2018 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system; renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.

Ð	Traffic Management on Sheppard Avenue West between Oakdale Road and Laura Road
H	Stage 1:
—	Lanes will be reduced on Sheppard Avenue West, with work taking place on the south side of Sheppard Avenue West. Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction.
	Stage 2:
	Work will move to the north side of Sheppard Avenue West. There will be no vehicular or cyclist access at Lomar Drive the intersection will be closed for 2 to 4 weeks. Access to Sheppard Avenue West shall be maintained via Laura Road. Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction.
	Local traffic, including access to all driveways, will be maintained.
大	Pedestrians: Sidewalks will be kept open for pedestrian use. When work is taking place on the sidewalk, signage will be placed to provide information about using the sidewalk
	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday.
	TTC Service: Sheppard Avenue West
	This project may affect travel times on the 84, 384 and 99 buses; visit ttc.ca for accurate schedule information. Some bus stop locations will be temporarily relocated along Sheppard Avenue West during construction.
