Expected Start Date: Spring 2020 Expected End Date: December 2020 Contract: 20ECS-LU-06SU.



The City of Toronto is planning to reline the storm sewer on Morningside Avenue from Military Trail to Ellesmere Road.

The storm sewer is an underground pipe designed to collect stormwater and melting snow and release it into a nearby creek or river. The part you own is from your house to the end of your property. The part the City owns is from the end of your property to the sewer.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2020 Capital Works Program to improve water distribution and renew aging infrastructure reducing the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
- Work in the boulevard in front of homes and commercial properties is expected. This work includes removing and replacing driveways, municipal sidewalks and grassed boulevards, where necessary.



Pre-Construction Notice

 Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and / or decorative objects. The City will <u>not</u> be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

Ŀ	Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the Field Ambassador to arrange for access during the construction period.
