SUPPORTING SHELTERS DURING COVID-19

- Investigate clients & staff who are COVID-19 positive, and identify close contacts who may have been exposed
- Work with shelters to maintain public health measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19
- Provide guidance on when PPE is required for clients & staff
- Actively work with city partners and shelters in the community to minimize the risk of COVID-19 outbreaks

- Screen clients & staff daily for symptoms of COVID-19
- Identify new infections as early as possible & isolate individuals
- Implement physical distancing measures
- Enhance cleaning and disinfection
- Train staff on COVID-19 infection prevention and control procedures
- Arrange an isolation space for a client who tests positive to recover in self-isolation
- Provide communication to staff & clients
