### Watermain Replacement on Gilley Road from Garratt Boulevard to Keswick Road

Contract: 19ECS-TI-11LR Start Date: April 20, 2020 End Date: May 30, 2020 \*Timeline is subject to change.

In 2019, the City of Toronto replaced the watermain on Gilley Road between Garratt Boulevard and Keswick Road. The contractor will return in April to replace the remaining substandard water services and complete permanent asphalt restoration.

#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO

The Province of Ontario has enacted a declaration of emergency to help contain the spread of COVID-19 and protect the public. A list of essential workplaces in Ontario was announced on March 23. As indicated on the list, City-led infrastructure construction has been deemed essential and this project will proceed. This construction is essential to ensure the City's infrastructure remain safe, in a state of good repair and able to meet Toronto's needs. #### WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Replace any City-owned water service pipes that do not meet City standards from the watermain to the private property line
- Restore all areas affected by construction
- Resurface the road

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# Construction Update #2

	<b>Water Service Disruptions:</b> From time-to-time, the water supply to your property will be shut-off to complete construction; the contractor will provide at least 24-hour advance notice. Throughout the work, it is recommended that you temporarily disconnect any water treatment systems (i.e. softeners or filters), water-cooled air conditioners or similar plumbing fixtures. Automatic lawn sprinkler systems may also be affected, therefore, you may need to water manually. In the event you did not received advanced notice, an <i>emergency water shut off</i> could have been necessary.
L <sub>ing</sub>	<b>Substandard Water Service Replacement:</b> Please take the time to read the attached fact sheet carefully as it contains important information on lead in drinking water and how to prepare for replacement. If you want to replace your part of the water service pipe, call the City's contractor for one of your quotes.

	<b>PLEASE NOTE</b> : any contract entered into to replace water services is between the home owner and the contractor.
÷	<b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
	<b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.
	Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i>
	<b>Restoration:</b> The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).
