Bridge Rehabilitation Don Mills Road over The Don Valley Parkway

Contract: 19ECS-TI-07BE Expected Start Date: April 2020 Expected End Date: August 2020 Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto will begin Phase 2 of the Don Mills Road over Don Valley Parkway (DVP) bridge rehabilitation to the top of the bridge. In Phase 1, work was completed on the underside of the bridge. **There will be no impacts to lanes on the Don Valley Parkway during this work. Don Mills Road and select DVP off-ramps to Don Mills Road will be temporarily signalized.**

This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2020 Capital Works Program.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO

The Province of Ontario has enacted a declaration of emergency to help contain the spread of COVID-19 and protect the public. A list of essential workplaces in Ontario was announced on March 23. As indicated on the list, City-led infrastructure construction has been deemed essential and this project will proceed. This construction is essential to ensure the City's infrastructure remain safe, in a state of good repair and able to meet Toronto's needs. WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- · Reconstruct the bridge parapet walls, railings, and expansion joints
- Perform concrete patch repairs to the deck surface
- Replace the deck waterproofing and asphalt surface

Work will be completed in two stages:

Stage and Dates	Traffic Management
Stage 1 (north side of bridge) April to June 2020	Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction
April to Julie 2020	direction
	Temporary traffic signals will be used to manage traffic on Don Mills Road and traffic exiting from the DVP.
Stage 2 (couth side of bridge)	Don Mills Road will be signalized in both
Stage 2 (south side of bridge) June to August 2020	directions at the bridge structure.
	The southbound DVP off-ramp to southbound Don Mills Road and the northbound DVP off-ramp to northbound Don Mills road will both be signalized.
	This may lead to increased congestion on Don Mills Road and the affected off-ramps.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m.to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday; 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Saturdays, with work after hours and on Sundays as required.
