F.G. Gardiner Expressway Substructure Repairs Bay Street On-Ramp

Contract: 20ECS-TI-01GE Expected Start Date: June 2020 Expected End Date: October 2020 *Timeline is subject to change.

As a result of an earlier fire incident near the Bay Street on-ramp to the eastbound F.G. Gardiner Expressway, the City of Toronto is expediting work to repair the girders and substructure underneath the ramp between Bay Street and Yonge Street.


The girders are pre-stressed concrete beams that support the deck. The substructure (bents) are the reinforced concrete columns and horizontal cap beams which support the girders and deck. This work will not affect the roadway.

This interim work is being undertaken to ensure the Gardiner Expressway remains in a safe and operable condition.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO

The Province of Ontario has enacted a declaration of emergency to help contain the spread of COVID-19 and protect the public. A list of essential workplaces in Ontario was announced on March 23 and revised on April 3. <u>(</u>)	Work Hours: Work will take place 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., Monday to Friday, and 9 a.m. to 7p.m., Saturday and Sunday.
Ė	Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, clear sidewalk path etc.) must contact the Communications Coordinator to arrange for access during the construction period.
