- 1. Sharif Jashim Khan** (Report No. 7271)
Applicant for Renewal of Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence No. D01-4650654

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, on consent.

Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence will renewed, subject to the following conditions;

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the licence may be cancelled;
- (2) The Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence will be suspended for five (5) days, beginning on Friday, June 19, 2020 starting at 12:00 a.m. until Tuesday, June 23, 2020 at 11:59 p.m.;
- (3) Upon being renewed, Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence will be placed on probation for a period of four (4) years. Sharif Jashim Khan is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Sharif Jashim Khan and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Sharif Jashim Khan's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 546 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (4) Prior to next renewal, Sharif Jashim Khan must submit, to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards, proof of completion of a Defensive Driving Course with the Ontario Safety Council;
- (5) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Sharif Jashim Khan or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and Report No. 7271 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
