
The City's contractor has completed the watermain replacement on Beth Nealson Drive and is starting sidewalk and road reconstruction work.

Starting on **June 29 until September 30**, Beth Nealson Drive will be reduced to one <u>southbound</u> lane in order to complete road reconstruction work safely and efficiently.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO

As restrictions on construction have been lifted by the Province of Ontario, City-led infrastructure will continue to proceed. During construction, the contractor is responsible for the Health & Safety on site under the Ontario Occupational Health and Safety Act and is expected to implement COVID-19 mitigation practices. WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION



Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.



Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.

Beth Nealson Drive will be reduced to one lane of southbound traffic.



TTC Service: Bus Route 88 South Leaside to St. Clair Station will be rerouted during the temporary restriction on Beth Nealson Drive. Travel times may be affected. Please see attached rerouting map.
