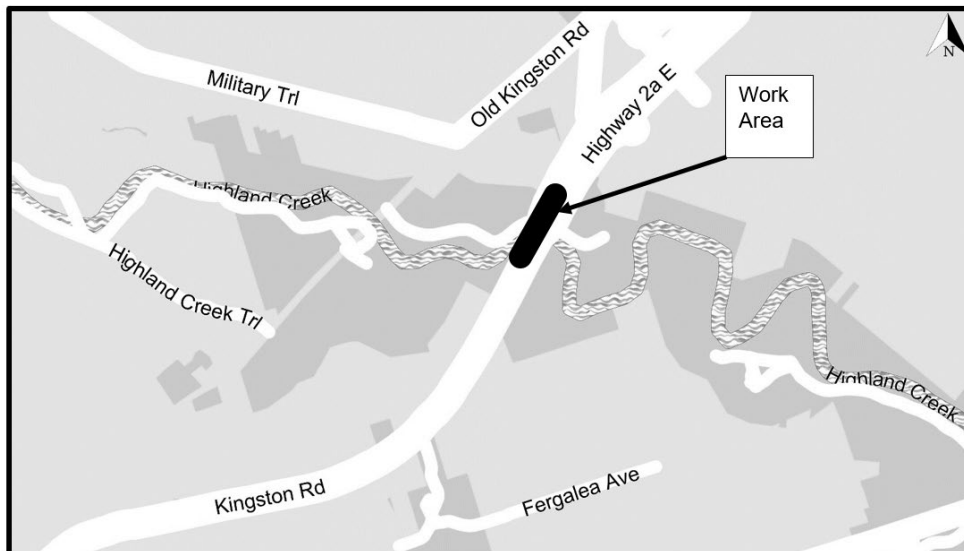

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the Kingston Road Bridge over Highland Creek starting in July 2020. The inspection of the bridge shows that there is a need to reconstruct the collapsed concrete slope paving at Colonel Danforth Park Trail and replace the leaking expansion joints. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2020 Capital Works Program.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO

As restrictions on construction have been lifted by the Province of Ontario, City-led infrastructure will continue to proceed. During construction, the contractor is responsible for the Health & Safety on site under the Ontario Occupational Health and Safety Act and is expected to implement COVID-19 mitigation practices. WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and the road with the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.



Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, clear sidewalk path, etc.) must contact the **Project Manager** to arrange for access during the construction period.
