Expected End Date: February 2021*

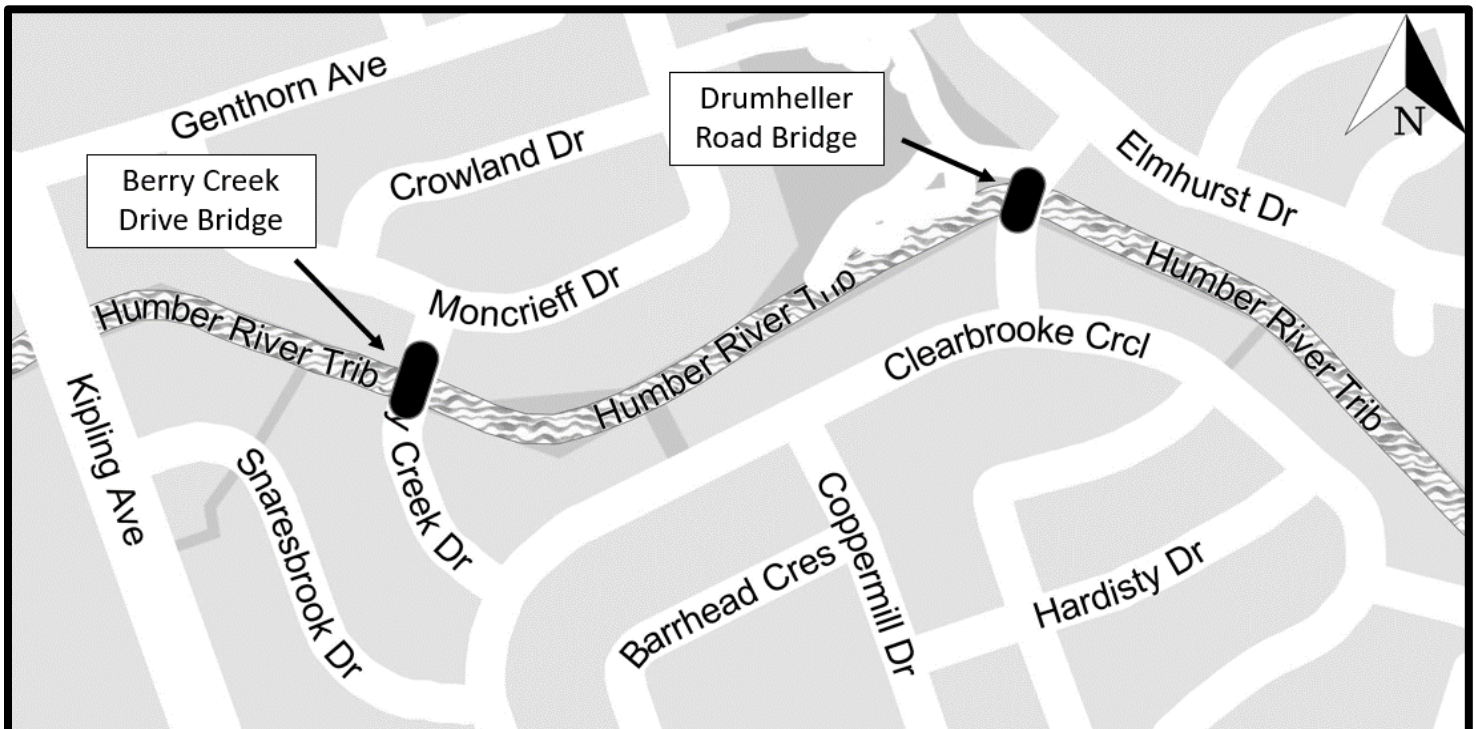

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate two bridges over Berry Creek, the Berry Creek Drive Bridge and Drumheller Road Bridge. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. This project is part of the 2020 Council-approved Capital Works Program.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO


As restrictions on construction have been lifted by the Province of Ontario, City-led infrastructure will continue to proceed. During construction, the contractor is responsible for the Health & Safety on site under the Ontario Occupational Health and Safety Act and is expected to implement COVID-19 mitigation practices. WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and the road with the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
