Storm Sewer Replacement on Brookdale Avenue

Expected Start Date: Summer 2020 Expected End Date: Fall 2020

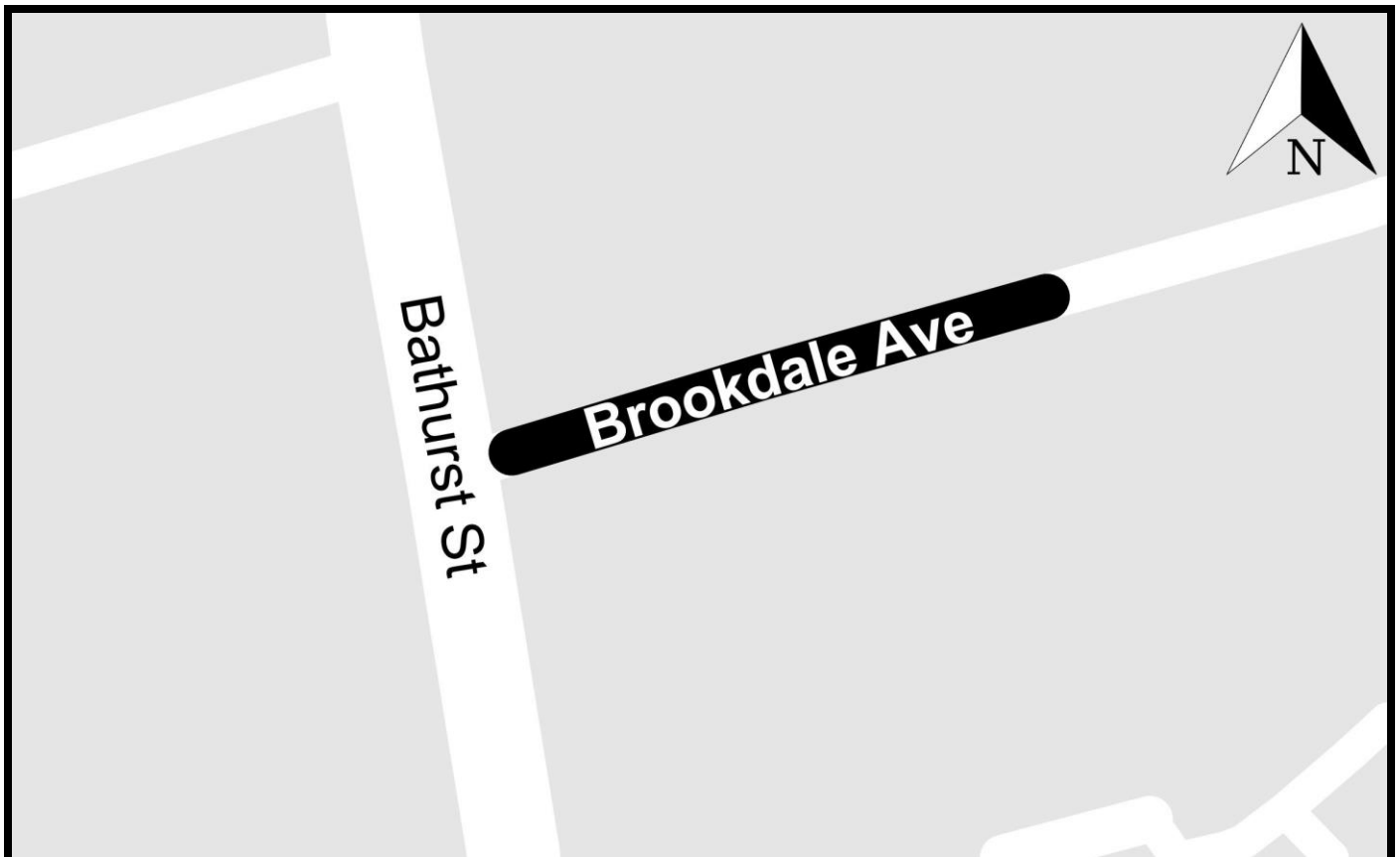

The City of Toronto is planning to replace the existing storm sewer on Brookdale Avenue, located approximately 60m east of Bathurst Street.

The storm sewer is a large underground pipe designed to collect stormwater and melting snow and release it into a nearby creek or river.




This project is part of the Council-approved 2020 Capital Works Program and the City's stormwater infrastructure improvement program that will improve the City's aging infrastructure to bring it to a good state of repair.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable to ensure they are not affected by the work.
- Before construction begins, a construction notice will be provided to area residents providing more precise information regarding the construction duration and specific closures.
- Work in the boulevard in front of homes and commercial properties is expected. This work includes removing and replacing of asphalt driveways, municipal sidewalks, curbs and grassed boulevards, where necessary.

	<p>Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the Project Manager to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
	<p>Access to Your Property: The City-hired contractor may need access to your property to complete a pre-construction survey. Affected properties will receive a pre-construction survey request to schedule a time to complete the survey.</p>
	<p>Tree Removal: Due to the nature of this project, the City will need to remove one (1) tree within the project limits to accommodate the proposed construction. A tree removal permit has been obtained in coordination with the City's Urban Forestry Division. Each tree removed for the project will be replaced using a replacement ratio of 3:1 or three trees planted for every one tree removed.</p>
