About the Conference:

The Conference 'Shaping Sustainable Futures for Internationalization in Higher Education (SSFIHE) 2019 was held at the Ontario Institute for Studies in Education (OISE), University of Toronto in partnership with the Humber College. The conference was attended by a number of academics and practitioners from Canada and abroad. The main themes of the Conference are quality, reciprocity and inclusion. These themes were explored in this conference as they relate to shaping sustainable futures for internationalization in higher education. There were a number of discussions, workshops and presentations that took stock of internationalization in higher education as it is currently evolving around the globe.

Benefits from attending the Conference:


