## Massey Creek Sanitary Trunk Sewer Rehabilitation near Taylor-Massey Creek

**Contract: 19ECS-LU-02TT**

**Expected Start Date: June 2020 Expected End Date: November 2021**

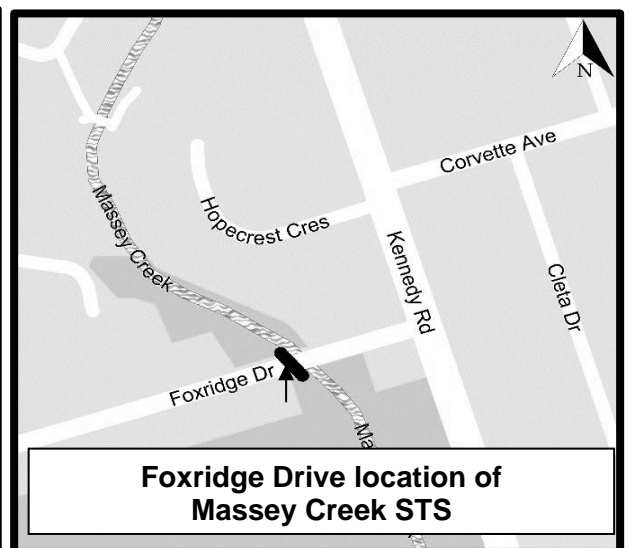
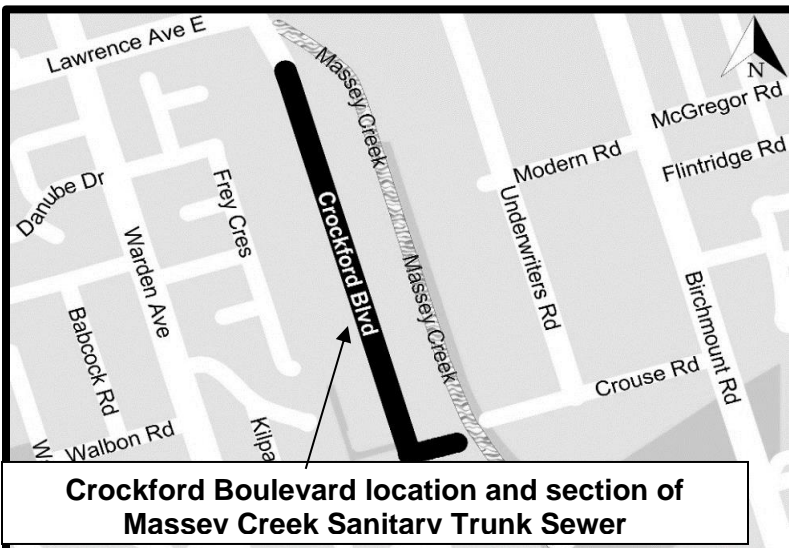
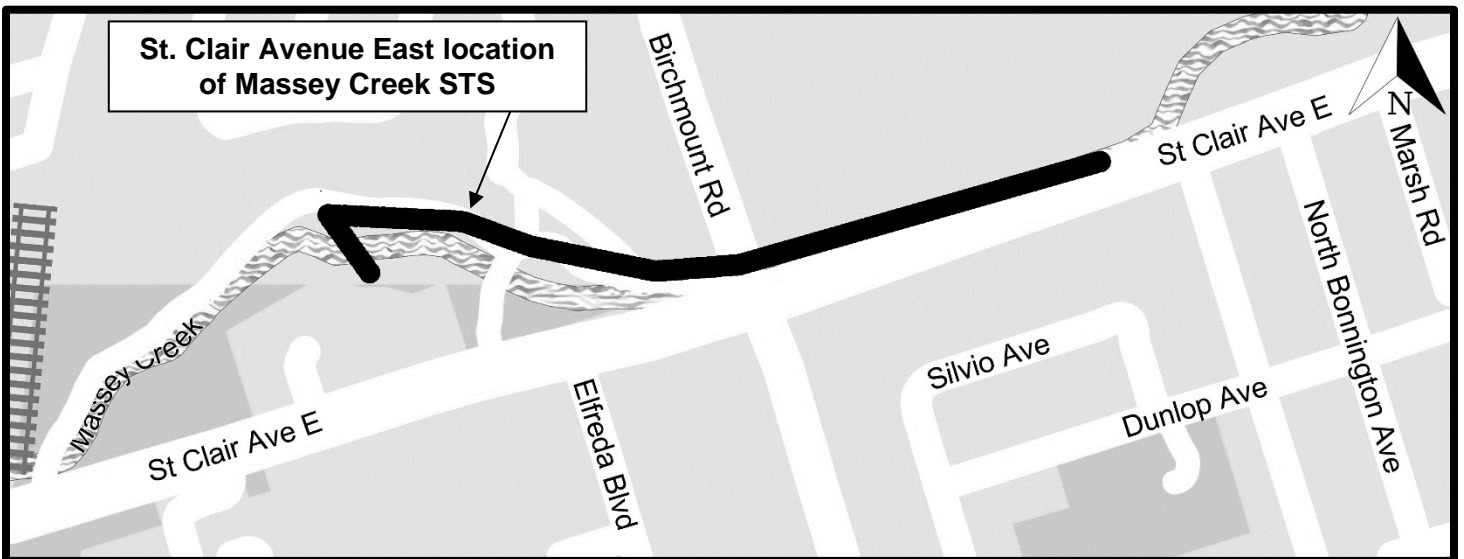
The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the Massey Creek Sanitary Trunk Sewer (STS) at the following locations:

- St. Clair Avenue East, located at the intersection of St. Clair Avenue East and Birchmount Road;
- Foxridge Drive, west of Kennedy Road; and
- Crockford Boulevard, located east of Crockford Boulevard between Lawrence Avenue and Underwriters Road/Crouse Road.

Sections of sewer located in the Taylor-Massey Creek ravine nearby St. Clair Avenue and Foxridge Drive will be abandoned as they are no longer appropriate for operation. The sanitary trunk sewer is an underground pipe that collects wastewater from various local sewers and conveys it to wastewater facilities for treatment.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2020 Capital Works Program to renew the City's aging sewer infrastructure and will extend the service life of these trunk sewer sections by approximately 50 years.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO

The Province of Ontario has enacted a declaration of emergency to help contain the spread of COVID-19 and protect the public. A list of essential workplaces in Ontario was announced on March 23. As indicated on the list, City-led infrastructure construction has been deemed essential and this project will proceed. This construction is essential to ensure the City's infrastructure remains safe, in a state of good repair and able to meet Toronto's needs. ## WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will move equipment on-site and prepare the work area before construction begins. Majority of the work is taking place on the roadways of St. Clair Avenue East and Crockford Boulevard.

- The sewer pipe will be rehabilitated using a trenchless method.
- Construction crews will install temporary pumps and pipes to divert flow from the sewer so that it can be repaired from the inside.
- A sock filled with resin will be inserted into the sewer pipe through maintenance holes and the sock is then cured with steam forming a new pipe inside the old sewer.

## WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Prior to construction starting in June 2020, a Construction Notice will be provided to residents providing more information regarding the construction duration and specific traffic closures.
- Work crews will mark underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable to ensure they are not affected by the work.
- Majority of this work will occur within Taylor-Massey Creek ravine, Toronto Region and

Conservation Authority lands. Limited work will occur on major and local roads and within right of way on St. Clair Avenue East, Foxridge Drive and Crockford Boulevard.
