
The City of Toronto will replace the Reesor Road culvert over Rouge Tributary. In order to complete this work safely the road will be closed at the work site and no traffic will be able to travel using Reesor Road between Steeles Avenue East and Old Finch Road.

This work will ensure that the new structure meets today's standards and remain safe for vehicles and pedestrians in the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2020 Capital Works Program.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO

As restrictions on construction have been lifted by the Province of Ontario, City-led infrastructure will continue to proceed. During construction, the contractor is responsible for the Health & Safety on site under the Ontario Occupational Health and Safety Act and is expected to implement COVID-19 mitigation practices. WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Remove the existing roadway;
- Replace the existing culvert below Reesor Road;
- · Reconstruct the roadway; and
- Restore the surrounding environment.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

 You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and weekend work as required.



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\$	Traffic Management: Efforts will be made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of the workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.
	Reesor Road will be closed with no access from Old Finch Avenue to Steeles Avenue East and vice versa for the duration of the construction.
Ė	Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the Field Ambassador to arrange for access during the construction period.
. :	Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).
