## Emergency Bridge Closure Twyn Rivers Drive over Rouge River

**Expected Start Date: Tuesday, July 14, 2020**

**Expected End Date: August 17, 2020**

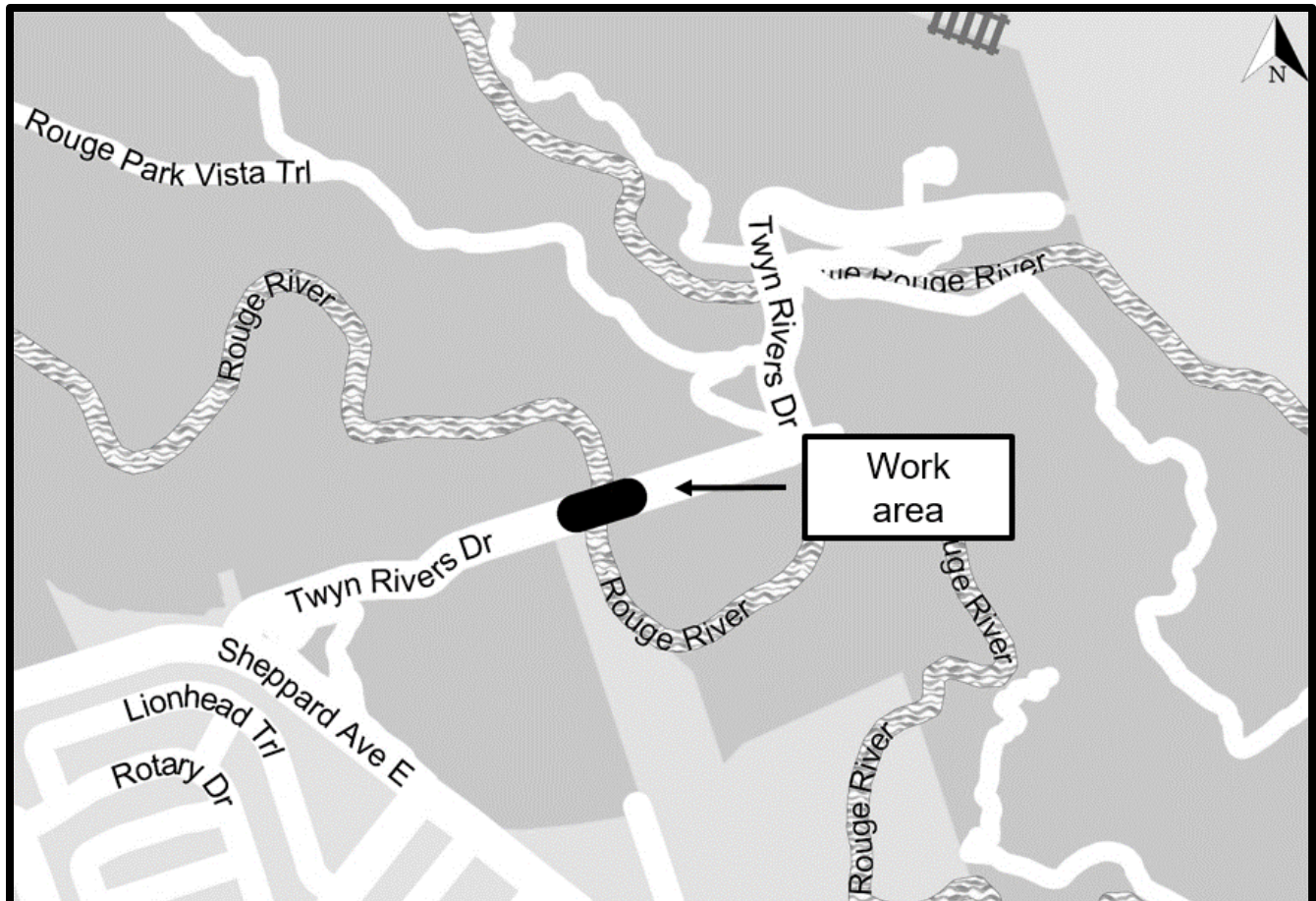

As a result of a recent inspection, the City of Toronto has temporarily closed the Twyn Rivers Drive over Rouge River and will complete emergency repairs to ensure the bridge remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians.

Due to the narrow width of the bridge, Twyn Rivers drive will be closed to pedestrians, cyclists and motorists for the duration of the repair work.

We recognize that this type of work is disruptive and the City is making every effort to complete the work as quickly as possible. Your patience during this emergency work is appreciated.

## WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Repair the bridge deck steel grating.
  - Install covering plates to damaged areas of the deck.
  - Restore capacity of girders affected.
- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone.</p> <p><b>Twyn Rivers drive will be closed.</b></p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p><b>Due to the narrow width of the bridge, Twyn Rivers drive will be closed for the duration of the work.</b></p>
	<p><b>Restoration:</b> The construction work area and regular two-way traffic will resume when work is complete.</p>
