The City of Toronto is completing a number of infrastructure improvements on Weston Road between Lawrence Avenue West to Humberview Crescent. The City is also improving the intersection of Jane Street and Trethewey Drive/Denison Road East.

The improvements are part of the Council-Approved 2019 budget and the City's Vision Zero Road Safety Plan that aims to create a safe and healthy city by eliminating all fatalities and serious injuries on city streets.
