- 1. Nathaniel Zvi Dreksler** (Report No. 7216)
Holder of Tow Truck Driver's Licence No. D09-4836022

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, on consent.

Tow Truck Driver's Licence will be subject to the following conditions;

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the licence may be cancelled;
- (2) Nathaniel Zvi Dreksler's Tow Truck Driver's Licence will be renewed and suspended for five (5) days. The suspension shall be in effect from 12:01 am on the first Monday following the Tribunal's order, and shall continue until 11:59 pm on the first Friday thereafter;
- (3) Tow Truck Driver's Licence will be placed on probation for a period of four (4) year(s). Nathaniel Zvi Dreksler is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Nathaniel Zvi Dreksler and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Nathaniel Zvi Dreksler's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 545 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (4) Prior to each of the next four (4) renewal(s) of the licence, Nathaniel Zvi Dreksler must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of his Criminal Record and Judicial Matters Check;
- (5) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Nathaniel Zvi Dreksler or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and Report No. 7216 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
