# Tuesday

# **Kryptonite Jelly**

#### **Supplies**

- Jell-o green mix
- Bowl
- Spoon
- Tray or ice cube tray

#### Instructions

- 1. Get a bowl
- 2. Make green jelly (use the Jell-o mix) follow instructions on the box
- 3. Pour into tray or ice cube tray
- 4. Once ready cut it into jagged cubes and serve the toxic kryptonite

# **Kryptonite Toss**

#### Supplies

- Buckets or large bins or cardboard boxes
- Foil (Optional)
- Balls

#### Instructions

- 1. Find 1-2 buckets/bins/ cardboard boxes
- 2. You can cover it with foil to look like a planet
- 3. Take Kryptonite (balls) and try to throw as many as you can at different distances

Challenge yourself by placing the planets 5 steps, 10 steps and 15 steps away from you

#### Superhero Masks

#### Supplies

- Paper Plate or poster board or foam sheet
- Construction paper
- Whole puncher or pencil
- String or ribbon
- Glue
- Optional: paint, feathers, glitter, sequins

#### Instructions

1. Draw your superhero mask shape out of a paper plate or poster board

- 2. Cut out eye holes any shape you want
- 3. Decorate as desired, then let dry
- 4. Hole punch each side of mask
- 5. Tie string or ribbon to each side of the mask to tie the mask on to your head.

# Superhero Tracing Chalk

#### Supplies

- Bowl or container
- Cornstarch
- Water
- Measuring cup
- Tempera Paint
- Spoon
- Ice cube tray

#### Instructions

- 1. Get a plastic bowl or recycled plastic container
- 2. Mix 1 cup of cornstarch and 1 cup of water
- 3. Add a little bit of washable tempera paint to create colour
- 4. Pour mixture into ice cube tray and put in freezer
- 5. Once frozen, take them outside on a sunny day and draw your superhero track on the sidewalk
- 6. Watch to see which ones melt the fastest

#### Wednesday

## **Superhero Number Maze**

#### Supplies

Chalk or Tape.

#### Instructions

- 1. Draw a grid
- 2. Pick any square, and write the number 1 inside
- 3. Choose any square that's next to the number 1 square, and write the number 2 inside
- 4. Choose any square that's next to the number 2 square, and write the number 3 inside
- 5. Continue writing in numbers in squares until all the squares are done
- 6. Decorate the starting and finishing squares so they stand out
- 7. Your maze is ready to go!

## **Superhero Matching Book**

Supplies

- Paper
- Scissors
- Glue

#### Instructions

- 1. Print superhero matching book template
- 2. Cut out superhero squares
- 3. Paste them onto the matching superhero page

# **Superhero Story Stone**

- Supplies
- Rocks
- Permanent colour pens
- Craft varnish
- Bag

#### Instructions

- 1. Collect 10-15 smooth rocks
- 2. Clean your pebbles
- 3. Think about what picture you want to draw on your stone
- 4. Using a permanent pen or permanent coloured pens, draw the pictures you like of places, objects, superhero's
- 5. Varnish stones to seal the colour (optional)
- 6. Let the stones dry
- 7. Put stones in a bag, as you pull one stone out at a time create a story

# Thursday

# **Superhero Movement Maze**

#### **Supplies**

Painter's Tape/Electrical Tape/Masking Tape.

#### Instructions

- 1. Use the painter's tape to create lines on the floor
- 2. Create a starting point use straight lines, Zig Zag lines, boxes etc., to design the maze to the finish line.
- 3. Get camper to balance on, hop, jump, or skip from line to line, box to box and more creative movements

#### Adaptations for mobile devices

Have the camper zig zag through, set a time to get from one spot to another, navigate with one eye open and create movements to be done once the camper gets to the maze destination

# Superhero Shield

#### Supplies

- 3 pieces of cardboard
- Scissors
- Glue
- Coloured duct tape
- Craft foam
- Construction paper

#### Instructions

- 1. Collect 3 pieces of cardboard, draw a circle on 1 piece of cardboard
- 2. Using the circle cut out to create two more circles
- 3. Use glue to attach all the circles together one on top of the other
- 4. Cover the edges of the shield with duct tape
- 5. Use colourful duct tape and cover the shield with long stripes of duct tape
- 6. Cut construction paper (colour of your choice) in a circle and glue or tape it to your shield
- 7. Create a superhero logo of your choice and glue it to the construction paper circle on your shield.
- 8. Cut a strip of craft foam and bend it into a C, then duct tape it to the back of your shield.

# **BAM! Sand**

#### Supplies

- Baby Oil (Large)
- Flour
- Plastic container or bin
- Superhero's, popsicle sticks, or anything else

#### Instructions

- 1. Pour 2-3 cups of flour in a bin or bowl
- 2. Add Baby Oil until you can mold the dough into a shape then through it in the bin for a BAM! Explosion
- 3. Use different materials to play, have fun!

# **Superhero Training Obstacle Course**

#### Supplies

# Adapted & Inclusive Virtual Camp

- Balls
- Bowls or buckets

#### Instructions

- 1. Make 4 stations
  - Station 1: 10 jumping jacks
  - Station 2: Throw the ball in the bucket 5 times
  - Station 3: Show your speed
  - Station 4: 10 ball lifts
- 2. Complete the obstacle course 3 times

## **Superhero Jet Pack**

#### Supplies

- Cereal box
- Packing tape or duct tape
- Construction paper and tissue paper (any colour)
- Ribbon or string (optional)
- Scissors

#### Instructions

- 3. Get a cereal box
- 4. Cover the cereal box with long strips of duct tape
- 5. To create straps for the jet pack, measure how long they need to be and then double the length (use string, ribbon or duct tape.
- 6. Cut 2 pieces of the material of your choice the length the straps need to be
- 7. Use a bit of tape to secure the straps to the cereal box, so it forms a backpack.
- 8. Take two toilet paper rolls and decorate them
- 9. Stuff the toilet paper rolls using tape with tissue paper to make flames
- 10. Attach the toilet paper rolls to the bottom of the cereal box
- 11. Your superhero is ready to jet off!

#### **Supplies**

- Paper
- Markers or crayons
- Scissors
- Construction paper (optional)
- Glue

#### Instructions

- 1. Print off bookmark template
- 2. Cut out bookmarks
- 3. Colour your bookmarks
