How Did We Get Here?


Geary Avenue Park expansion builds on the 2019 master plan work for the Green Line linear park system.

What We Heard! Master Plan Consultation


























Concept Plan Options At A Glance West of Dovercourt Rd



Option 1 - Ribbon Pathway






