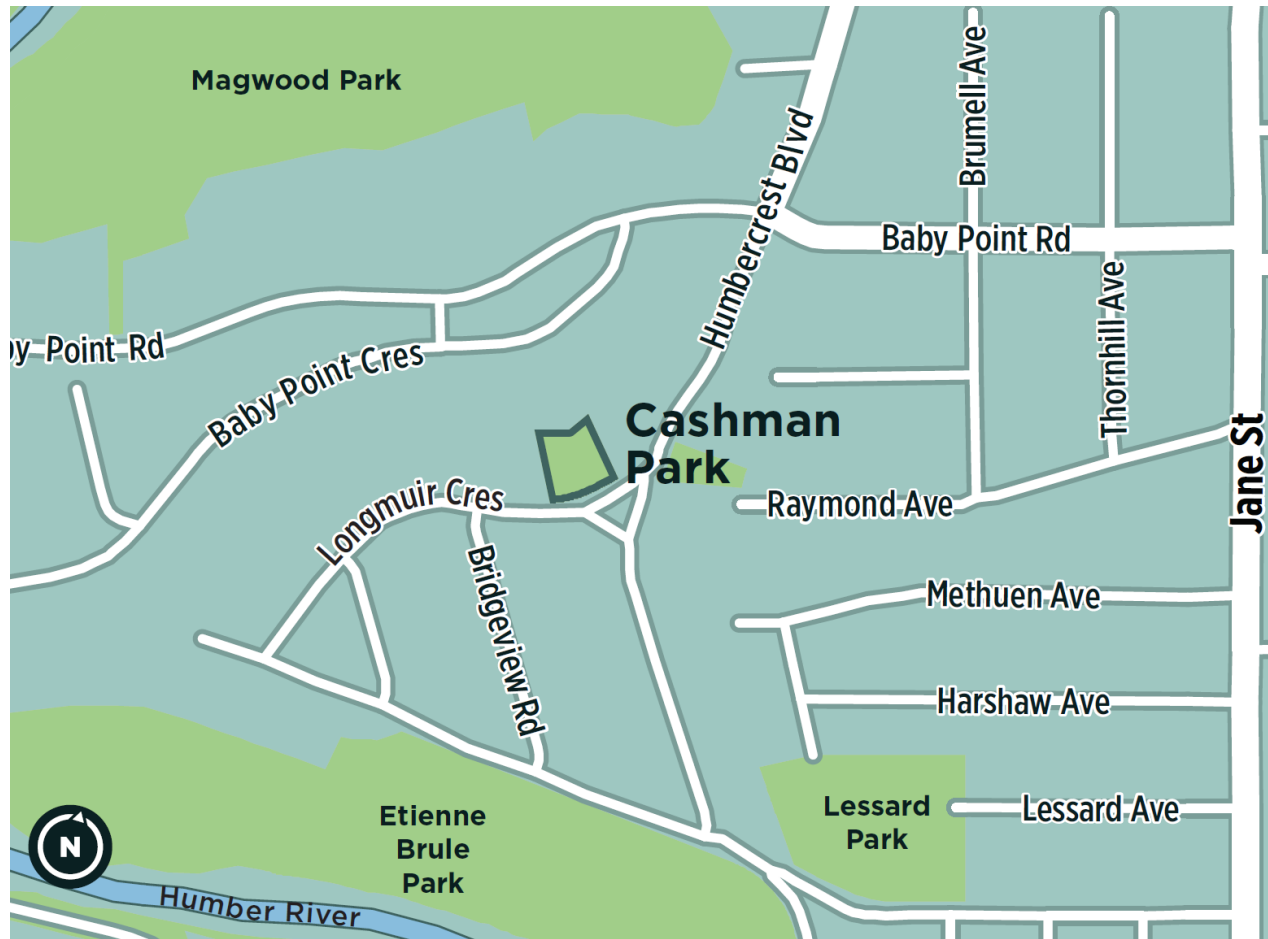

## DO-IT-YOURSELF (DIY) WORKSHOP KIT

### Facilitator Instructions

- Set up a workshop area (e.g. a kitchen table):
  - Set out one print or digital copy of this workshop kit. This is where the note taker will sit to take notes.
  - Give each participant a piece of paper and a pen or pencil so they can take their own notes. Make sure everyone knows that only the workshop kit will be submitted, and that the note taker will capture their thoughts.
  - Set out any refreshments (optional).
- Start the workshop with a round of introductions. Ask participants to share their name, and a memory they have at Cashman Park.
- After reading the project background together, work through each activity. Make sure each participant has the opportunity to provide their feedback for each question. Make sure the pace of discussion is slow enough that the note taker can keep up.
- Once your workshop is complete, thank everyone and submit your results online!

# CASHMAN PARK IMPROVEMENTS

## BACKGROUND - WHAT HAPPENED SO FAR & WHERE ARE WE NOW?

In 2019, the Cashman Park playground structure was removed because of safety concerns as the old playground structure aged and deteriorated. A swing set and spring toy are now the only equipment in the park's playground.

Cashman Park is located on a hill, and replacing the playground equipment in its previous location on top of the hill presents some design and accessibility challenges.

All new play equipment must include an accessible pathway, so people of all abilities can get to the new structures. To accommodate an accessible pathway to the top of Cashman Park's hill would require a large landscaping changes, including a "switchback path". A switchback path is a paved pathway that zigzags up a hill. The switchback path is not steep, so that people can roll up or down the ramp safely. These ramps require a lot of space. If installed at Cashman Park, they would leave very little space on the site for playground equipment.

Another challenge is that play equipment cannot be installed close to the sidewalk or street due to safety concerns.

Given these constraints, the City is consulting with community members to determine an alternative park improvement that will not include replacing the playground equipment that has already been removed.
