Steeles Avenue East Bridge Rehabilitation over Little Rouge Creek

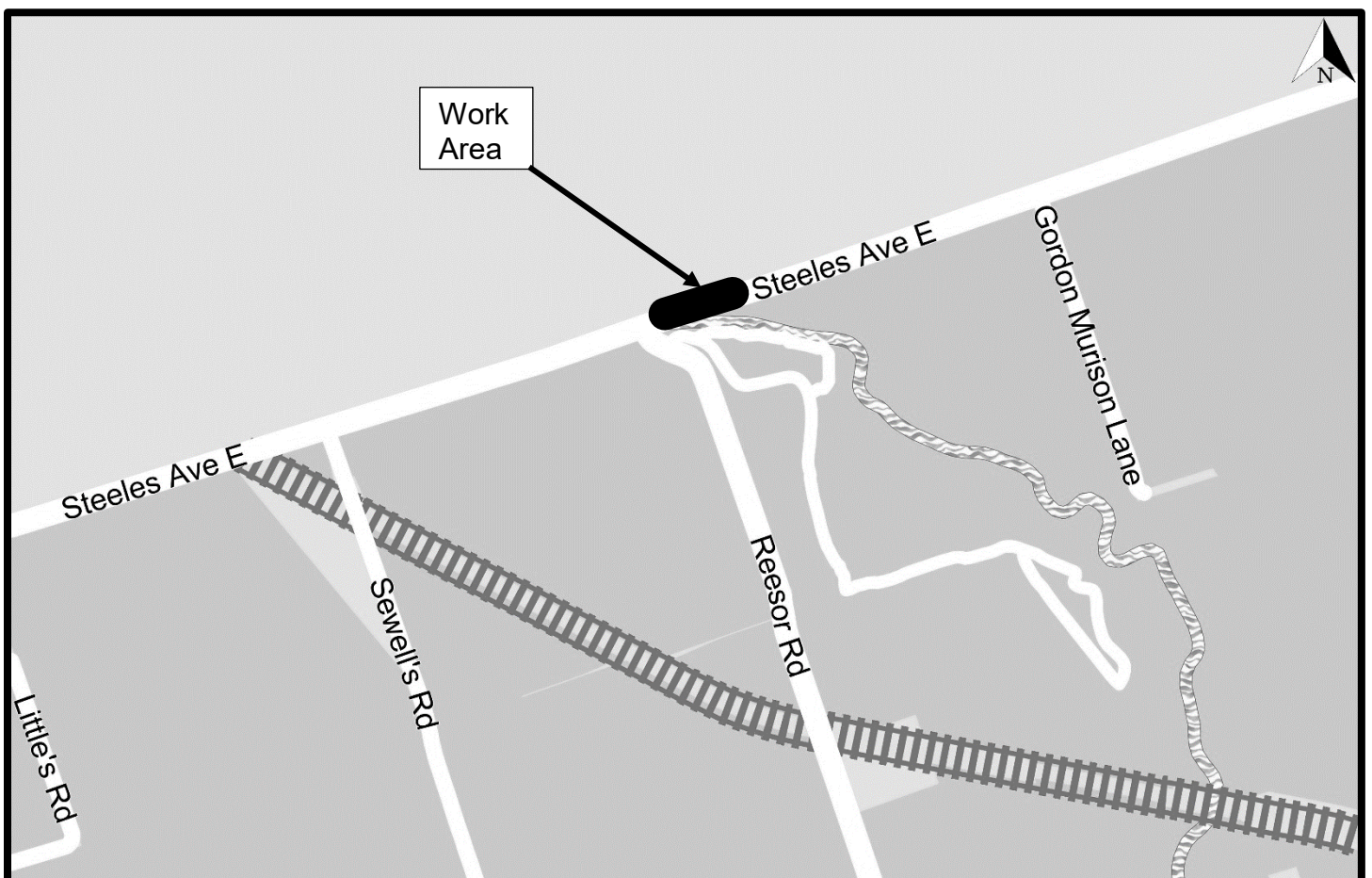

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the Steeles Avenue East Bridge over Little Rouge Creek near Reesor Road starting in August 2020. The inspection of the bridge shows that there is a need to repair a sinkhole at the bridge. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2020 Capital Works Program.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO

As restrictions on construction have been lifted by the Province of Ontario, City-led infrastructure will continue to proceed. During construction, the contractor is responsible for the Health & Safety on site under the Ontario Occupational Health and Safety Act and is expected to implement COVID-19 mitigation practices. The City's contractor will:

- Repair existing steel sheet pile wall
- Construct new armour stone wall

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Saturday, with work after hours and on Sundays and statutory holidays as required.</p>
	<p>Road Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>For the duration of the project, the westbound lane of Steeles Avenue will be closed at the work area and a flag person will be provided at each end of the closure to direct traffic.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, clear sidewalk path, etc.) must contact the Project Engineer to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
