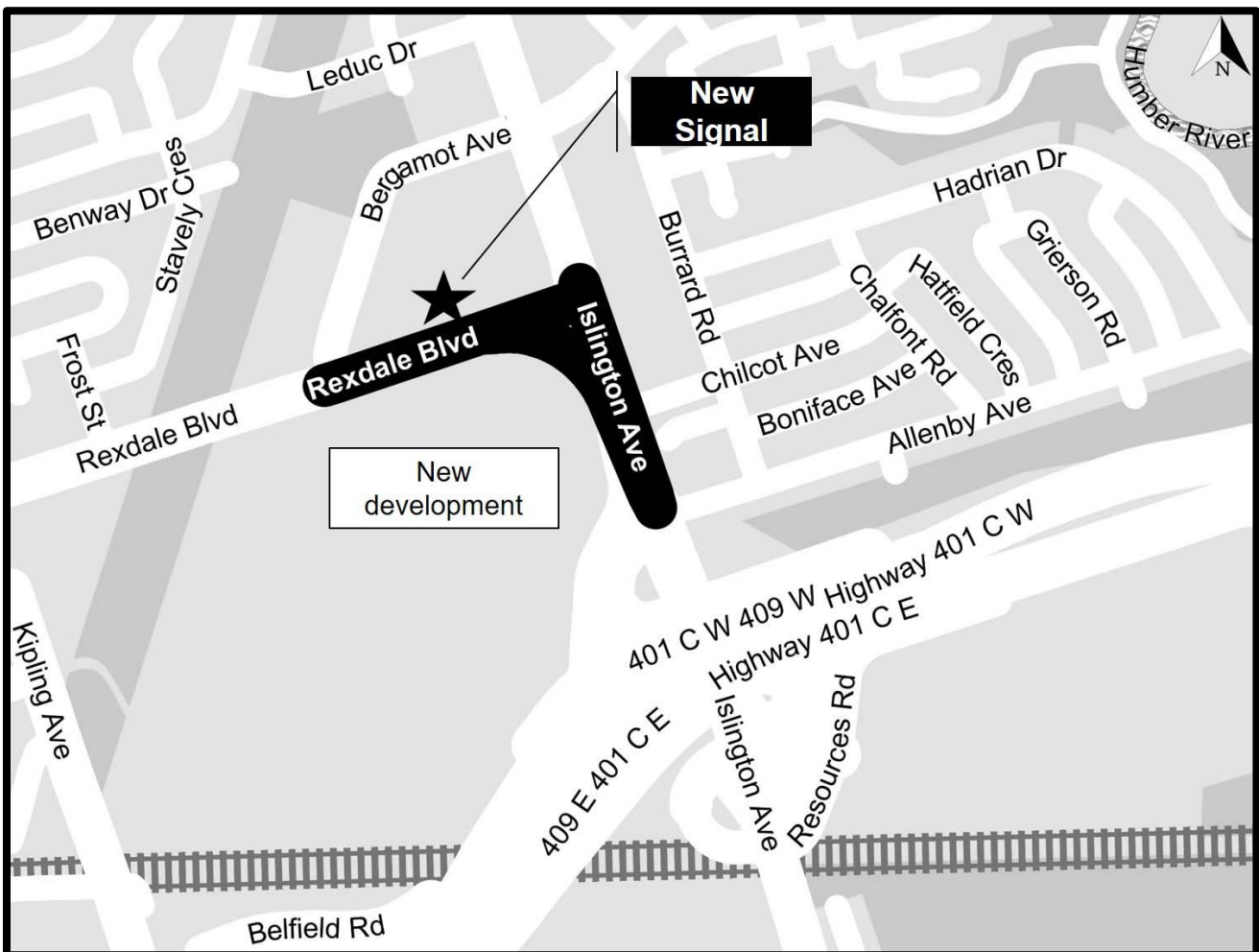
As part of new development, the Developer will reconstruct the road and sidewalks on Islington Avenue and Rexdale Boulevard from Bergamot Avenue to Allenby Avenue and improve the intersection at Islington Avenue and Rexdale Boulevard for the City of Toronto.

New developments in the area require improved roads and a more effective intersection design, resulting in improved traffic flow and increased safety improvements for all road users.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO

As restrictions on construction have been lifted by the Province of Ontario, City-led infrastructure will continue to proceed. During construction, the contractor is responsible for the Health & Safety on site under the Ontario Occupational Health and Safety Act and is expected to implement COVID-19 mitigation practices. WORK DETAILS

In phases, the contractor will:

- Dig up the road surface, base concrete and entire right of way (medians, sidewalks, and boulevard)
- Install a new water service connection to the watermain and a signalized intersection on the south side of Rexdale Boulevard between Bergamot Avenue and Islington Avenue
- Realign the Islington Avenue and Rexdale Boulevard Intersection (removing the right turn channel, replacing signals etc.)
- Replacing signalized intersection, crosswalks, sidewalks, medians and landscape areas
- Reconstruct the curbs sidewalks and road

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>Traffic through the work zones on Islington Avenue and Rexdale Boulevard will be reduced to one lane in each direction.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the Project Manager to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
	<p>TTC Service: This project may affect travel times on the 37A, 37B Islington. Visit ttc.ca for accurate schedule information.</p>
	<p>Restoration: Areas affected by construction will be restored.</p>
