
# TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE Hove Street between Codsell Avenue and Sheppard Avenue

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary sewer system in your area to reduce surface and basement flooding.

Due to the depth and nature of the storm sewer construction work on Hove Street, the road will be closed between Codsell Avenue and Sheppard Avenue, effective 7 a.m. on Friday August 7, 2020 to 7 p.m. on Wednesday August 19, 2020. We apologize for the inconvenience.

8	Traffic Management: Hove Street will be fully closed to outside traffic. Please see detour around the closed section of the street on page one of this Construction Notice. Local traffic including access/egress to all driveways will be maintained.
