Road and Sidewalk Reconstruction on Glen Road north of Summerhill Avenue

Contract: 18ECS-TI-19LR

Original Start/End Date: April 22, 2019 / October 31, 2019 Summerhill Ave to north end: August 31, 2020 – September 30, 2020

REVISED End Date: September 30, 2020


The reconstruction of the sidewalk and road on Glen Road from Summerhill Avenue to the north end will start on August 31, 2020. In order to keep residents and workers safe, parking on the street will be restricted. Only the northbound lane of traffic will remain open (please refer to map below).

Construction delays: The City is experiencing some challenges with the contractor and its delay with the schedule of the road reconstruction phase of work on Glen Road. The City is reviewing the contract conditions for this project in order to penalize the contractor for the delay. There are no additional costs to the City due to the delay.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO

As restrictions on construction have been lifted by the Province of Ontario, City-led infrastructure will continue to proceed. During construction, the contractor is responsible for the Health & Safety on site under the Ontario Occupational Health and Safety Act and is expected to implement COVID-19 mitigation practices. North of Summerhill Ave to 337 Glen Rd August 31 to September 30

- Summerhill Avenue traffic on Douglas Drive will be able to turn north onto Glen Road.
- The lane at the north end of Glen Road will be open to one way (northeast) traffic to allow for local traffic to exit the construction area.

PROGRESS UPDATE

From August 31 to September 30, 2020 the contractor will:


- Complete the road reconstruction from Summerhill Avenue to the north end.
- Only the northbound lane of traffic will remain open.
- Restoration of driveways and green areas will be completed in October.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday; 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Saturdays, with work after hours and on Sundays as required.



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Physical Distancing

There are times when contractors need to communicate with homeowners about what is happening on-site. This could be about driveway access and site restoration work (landscaping, installing pavers etc.). Contractor's staff will be identifiable by their high-visibility clothing. Where possible, a phone number for a contact person on-site will be provided on notices, to answer questions about work near your property. At other times, the contractor may knock on your door, but will then step away the required distance to discuss the work that is taking place and what can be expected that day. Please practice physical distancing with workers so everyone can remain safe. If you have questions, call the contact provided on this notice.



Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.



Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at **416-808-2222**.

In the event you receive a traffic ticket for on-street parking during this period of construction, you may choose to dispute your ticket following the process listed on the reverse side of the parking infraction notice. You may use this notice as part of your defence for parking consideration during construction; however, the Project Manager does not have the authority to cancel any parking tickets.



TTC Service: This project will affect travel times on the 82 Rosedale bus; the 82 Rosedale bus will divert its return route and take Edgar Avenue instead of Highland Avenue. Some bus stop locations may be temporarily re-located along Glen Road during construction. Information about temporary route changes will be posted on TTC bus stops.

Garbage and Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. *Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.*



Restoration: Areas affected by construction will be restored.
