#### **CONSTRUCTION UPDATE**


The sewer upgrades along St Clair Avenue East are expected to be completed by Friday, July 12, 2019. The road will be restored and all lanes will be open.

Due to additional time required to obtain permits for the work on Glenwood Crescent between Glenwood Terrace and St. Columba Place, our contractor will begin sewer upgrades at the north east section of Glenwood Crescent between Glen Gannon Drive and Rexleigh Drive. This work will take place **July 15 to August 9, 2019**; during this work one lane of traffic on Glenwood Crescent will be closed as work is performed on the south side of the street. If there are any impacts to your driveway access, our contractor will notify you 24 hours before the impact.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT LEAD WATER SERVICES

If you live on Glenwood Crescent in a house that was built before the mid-1950s, your water service may be made of lead. Please read the attached fact sheet with important information about the risks of lead water services, especially if someone in your house is pregnant, there are children under six years old, or there is an infant drinking formula made using tap water.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may continue to experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.



**Work Hours**: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekend as required.



Water Service Disruptions: From time-to-time, the water supply to your property will be shut-off to complete construction; the Contractor will provide at least 24-hour advance notice. Throughout the work, it is recommended that you temporarily disconnect any water treatment systems (i.e. softeners or filters), water-cooled air conditioners or similar plumbing fixtures. Automatic lawn sprinkler systems may also be affected, therefore, you may need to water manually. In the event you did not receive advanced notice, an *emergency water shut off* may have been necessary.



**Substandard Water Service Replacement:** Please take the time to read the attached fact sheet carefully as it contains important information on lead in drinking water and how to prepare for replacement. If you want to replace your part of the water service pipe, contact the City's contractor for one of your quotes.

**PLEASE NOTE**: (any contract entered into to replace water services is between the home owner and the contractor.)



**Road and Sidewalk Access:** In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.



**Traffic Management**: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.

During Phase 3 work, one lane of traffic on Glenwood Crescent will be closed as work is performed on the south side of the street. If there are any impacts to your driveway access, our contractor will notify you 24 hours before the impact

**Parking:** Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at **416-808-2222**.

In the event you receive a traffic ticket for on-street parking during this period of construction, you may choose to dispute your ticket following the process listed on the reverse side of the parking infraction notice.

You may use this notice as part of your defense for parking consideration during construction; however, the Field Ambassador does not have the authority to cancel any parking tickets.



**Accommodation:** Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact City staff at 416-392-6681 or <a href="mailto:bfppinquiries@toronto.ca">bfppinquiries@toronto.ca</a>.



**Garbage & Recycling**: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the Contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them.

Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.



**Restoration:** The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).
