Construction update

Site preparation is anticipated to begin at the 150 Harrison St. site starting September 14, 2020 including installing construction fencing and tree protection hoarding. Once the site preparation is complete, the building foundation work will begin. This work is expected to be complete in mid-October.

Builders and their trades have been asked to be mindful of the adjacent neighbourhood during construction hours. New Ontario government regulations allow construction activities 7 days a week (including holidays) from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm.
