TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS related to the Watermain Replacement work on Beth Nealson Drive

The City's contractor has completed the watermain replacement on Beth Nealson Drive and is completing sidewalk and road reconstruction work.

In order to reconstruct the intersection at Pat Moore Drive and Beth Nealson Drive the intersection will be closed to northbound traffic from **September 23 to October 7**.

- One southbound lane will be open from Wicksteed Avenue through the intersection at Pat Moore Drive.
- Northbound traffic from Overlea Boulevard can only access up to 111 Thorncliffe Park Drive; there will be no access to Beth Nealson Drive or Pat Moore Drive.
- Eastbound traffic on Pat Moore Drive will be able to make a right turn only onto Thorncliffe Park Drive.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

÷	Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
	Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.
8	Traffic Management : Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.
	Beth Nealson Drive will be reduced to one lane of southbound traffic. Please refer to map on page 1.
	TTC Service: Bus Route 88 South Leaside to St. Clair Station will be rerouted during the temporary restriction on Beth Nealson Drive. Travel times may be affected. Please see attached rerouting map.
