## Basement Flooding Protection Program on St. Clair Avenue East, St. Columba and Glenwood Crescent

Contract: 18ECS-LU-04FP

*\*Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto and the contractor are exploring an accelerated schedule that would allow more time to complete the work as it progresses towards St. Columba Place and St. Clair Avenue East in order to complete the project by the end of 2020.

The accelerated schedule includes working on Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. allowing restoration work to start sooner, which is a top priority for the community. Some underground work, such as the installation of sewers, watermain and water/sewer services would also take place on Saturdays.

We will try Saturday work starting September 12 for two weekends, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. In addition, Trisan has already started working extended hours on weekdays, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Saturday work will be re-evaluated based on resident feedback and how the work is progressing. Updates will continue to be provided as the project advances.

The next phases of the box culvert installation are expected to be less disruptive to the community as the work will be taking place on St. Columba and St. Clair. During these phases, Glenwood Crescent will be re-opened to through traffic. Intermittent road closures for about one week may be required when the new watermain is being installed between Stag Hill and St. Columba.

The following work remains:

- Storm sewer box culvert and sanitary sewer installation from the current work location on Glenwood/St. Columba to the intersection of St. Clair and St. Columba;
- Watermain installation and water/sewer service replacements on Glenwood/St. Columba from Stag Hill to St. Clair Avenue East;
- Road restoration on Glenwood/St. Columba from Stag Hill to St. Clair Avenue East, Glenwood from Glen Gannon to Rexleigh and on St. Clair from 50 metres east of O'Connor to St. Columba;
- Restoration of all impacted driveways;
- Sidewalk restoration on Glenwood/St. Columba from Stag Hill to St. Clair Avenue East;
- Landscape restoration in all affected areas (tree planting, sod, etc.).
