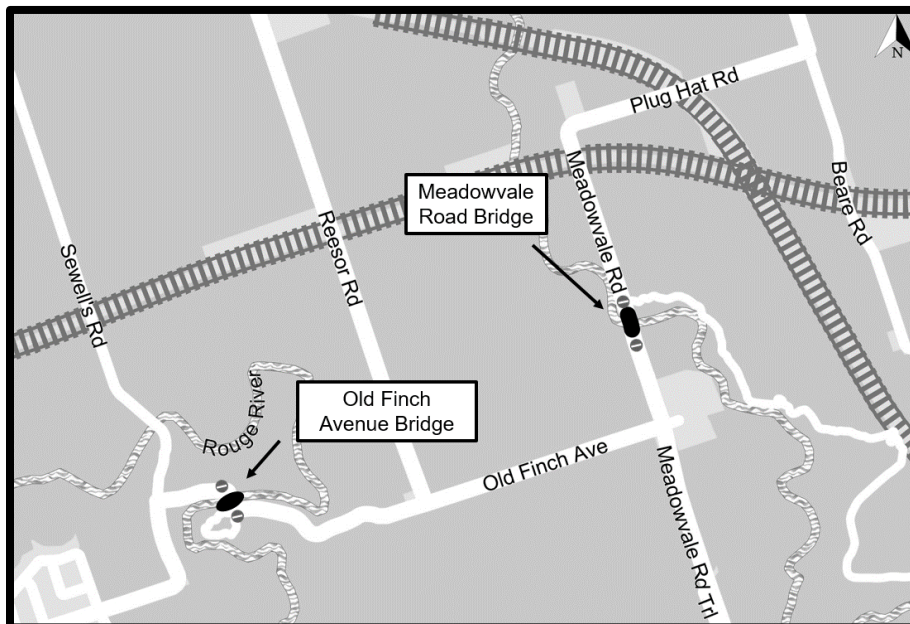
The City of Toronto will carry out the structural steel inspection of Old Finch Avenue Bridge over Rouge River on November 2, 2020 and Meadowvale Road Bridge over Little Rouge River on November 3, 2020. This work will help the City determine the level of work needed for an upcoming rehabilitation and ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future.

Due to the narrowness of these bridges, they will be temporarily closed during the inspections.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO

Inspection crews will:

- Utilize rope access technique to gain access to normally inaccessible areas
- Carry out the structural steel inspection
- Complete non-destructive tests at selected steel members

	<p>Work Hours:</p> <p>Old Finch Avenue Bridge over Rouge River: 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on November 2, 2020</p> <p>Meadowvale Road Bridge over Little Rouge River: 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on November 3, 2020</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be entranceway and walkway interruptions within the inspection work area.</p> <p>On November 2, 2020, Old Finch Avenue Bridge over Rouge River will be closed.</p> <p>On November 3, 2020, Meadowvale Road Bridge over Little Rouge River will be closed.</p> <p>Access to local properties within the affected roadway will be maintained.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers and road users. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>In order to complete this work, road closure traffic control will be in place in the area where crews are working, and advanced road closure signs will be installed.</p>
	<p>Site Safety: Workers on site are responsible for the work assigned to them. If you have construction questions or an issue on site – ask to be directed to the site inspector. If the site inspector is unavailable, contact the person listed at the end of this notice.</p>
