Describe the benefits from attending the Conference (including any benefits to you and to the City):

Earlier this month, I attended a Gilding Workshop organized by the Art Conservation Program at Queen's
University. It was taught by Sacha Marie Levay who is the Frame Conservator at the Montreal Museum of Fine
Arts. This workshop covered conservation/restoration techniques including hands-on instruction in both
traditional oil and water gilding, as well as a variety of finishing techniques such as pastiglia and fluting. We
were also introduced to the history and conservation of gilding. Topics included how to make traditional gesso,
boule, and how to apply gold leaf and use burnishing tools. We were also able to discuss the history of frames
as well as the ethics of treating and preserving gilt frames and furniture.

Participation in this workshop directly benefits work that I undertake at Museums Services by providing me with the knowledge and skills to preserve and conserve gilded framed works of art. I feel this experience will help me make more informed treatment decisions with regards to other decorative gilded items.

Personal Development:

This is the only introductory workshop on gilding that I am aware of in Canada that also discusses gilding from a conservation and preservation perspective. I gained new skills that I can directly apply to my work as a conservator at the City of Toronto. Many of the topics covered will have a direct benefit with my work a conservator and allow me to build on existing skills and training. I have a new appreciation and enthusiasm for this type of artifact and I'm eager to hone my new skills.

Networking:

I was able to meet conservation students and colleagues, while promoting conservation activities at Museums Services. I was also able to make some new connections within the conservation community which will undoubtedly serve Museums Services well when requiring outside advice or guidance in the future.

City Benefits (including financial benefits):

The types of artifacts in the City of Toronto's collection are diverse and include gilded frames and artifacts. I gained valuable hands-on skills and learned about new ways to treat and plan for the preservation of these cultural heritage objects. The course handbook will be a good future resource for the City's conservation lab. Most importantly, I have been able to share new information with my colleagues which will benefit the artifacts here at the Collections and Conservation Centre as well as the City of Toronto's historic sites.
