Scarborough Waterfront Combined Sewer Overflows Stormwater Outfall Control & Flood Protection Study

Notice of Study Recommendations availability

Study Overview

The City of Toronto has updated some recommendations to the 2011 Scarborough Waterfront CSO and Stormwater Outfalls Control Class Environmental Assessment (EA) and Flood Protection Study. The Study Addendum identifies solutions to reduce the risk of future flooding, address combined sewer overflow control and water quality.

The proposed recommendations include:

- Install an underground combined sewage storage tank at the south end of Warden Avenue to store excessive storm and combined sewage during heavy rain periods
- Eliminate several sewer system interconnections (between storm and combined sewer system)
- Upgrade/realign up to 28 km of sewers (primarily storm sewers)
- Install up to 6 km of new storm sewers
- Implement source control measures on City land
- Continue to promote the City's Downspout Disconnection Program

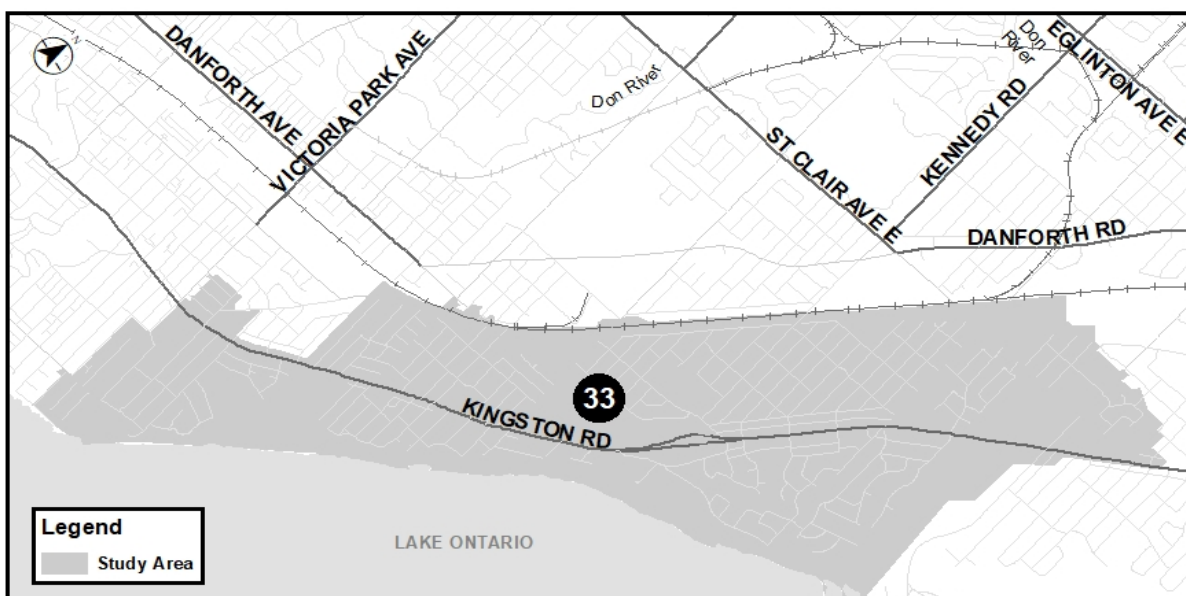

The Addendum is being planned as a Schedule C undertaking under the Municipal Class EA Process. The Addendum will identify the problem/opportunity, update existing and future conditions, update and evaluate the alternative solutions, recommend a preferred set of solutions, and identify measures to lessen any adverse impacts from the recommended solutions.
