City Construction on Dovercourt Road from Sudbury Street to College Street and Lisgar Street from Queen Street West to Dundas Street West

Contracts: 20ECS-TI-103LR and 20ECS-LU-16SU

This notice provides an update on a number of construction projects in the Beaconsfield Village neighbourhood.

The City of Toronto is continuing to replace the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Dovercourt Road (Queen Street West to College Street). Work is nearing completion of sanitary sewer and watermain replacement and road resurfacing on Lisgar Street (Queen Street West to Dundas Street West).

We know these projects continue to have an impact to all businesses and residents in the area. We sympathize and appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, parking, fencing and other inconveniences.

- **This work will continue to have an impact on traffic / parking in the neighbourhood, particularly on Dovercourt Road (Queen to College) and Lisgar Street (Queen to Dundas). Please refer to the Traffic Management Update section on page 2 for additional details.**
- **The City's contractor will continue working throughout the winter months on Dovercourt Road. They will pause work between Dec. 23, 2020 and Jan. 4, 2021.**

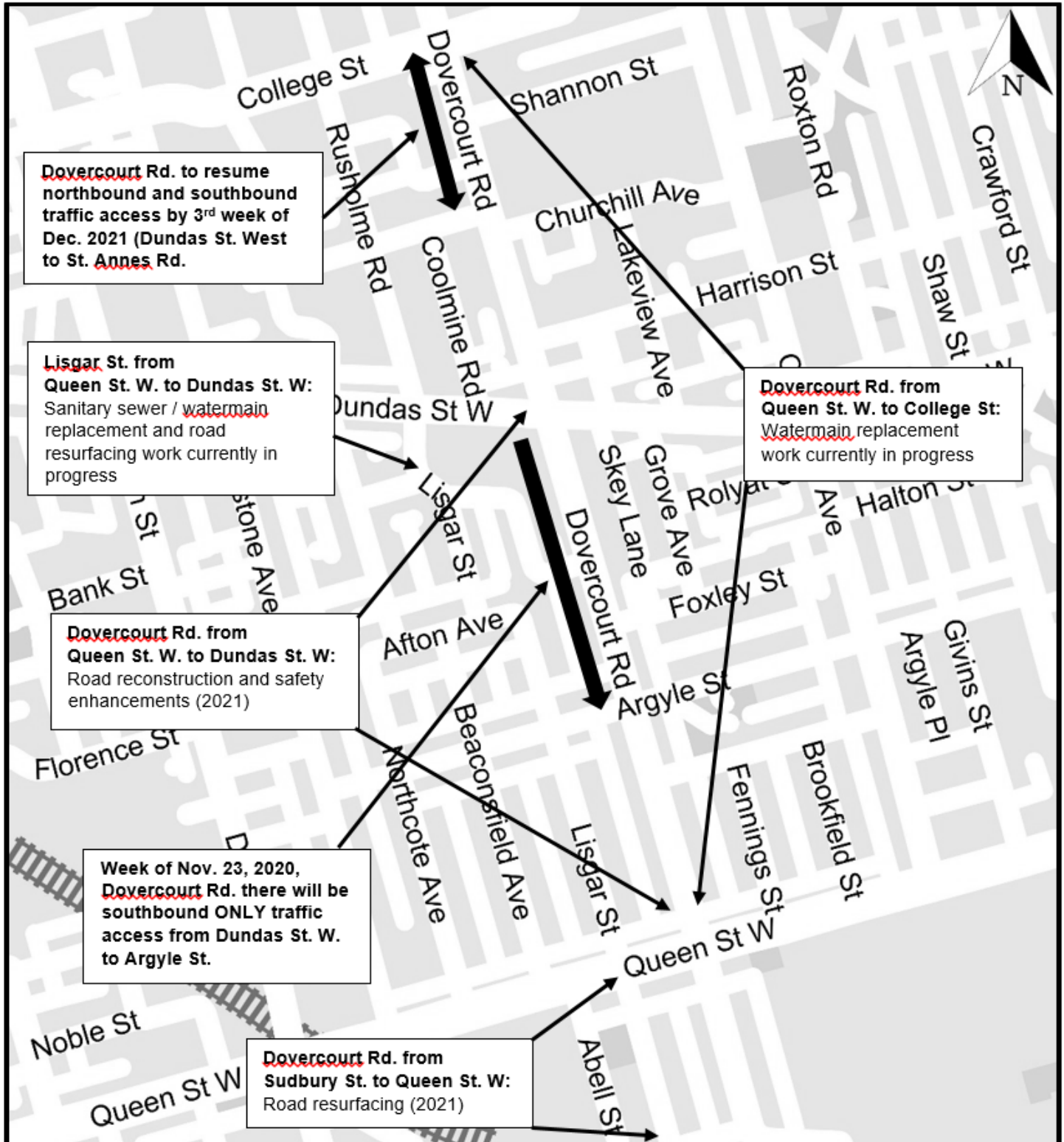
IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO

A separate notice with additional information was recently delivered to affected residents.
