Introduction

Access to records held by the City of Toronto is regulated by the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (Acronym: MFIPPA). The public has a right to see most City records, and to get copies of them (fees for photocopying may apply). There are some exceptions to public access.

Records are made available by:

- Routine disclosure: Divisions automatically make information available to the public when it is requested, and by publishing it online or in a printed form such as brochures and reports.
- Freedom of information request: When information is not available routinely, the public may submit a freedom of information request to the City Clerk's Office, Corporate Information Management Services.

Routine Disclosure Plan

This document describes the types of records available routinely from the Engineering and Construction Services Division. It identifies the type of information, a brief description, and how it is made available to the public (online, by request, or by visiting a City office).

These maps include: DMOG (Digital Map Owners Group) maps, which includes 3rd party utilities, street lighting and sewer and water infrastructure. (only for the former City of Toronto) CUMAP (City Utility Mapping) which includes street lighting and sewer and water infrastructure (Citywide). Soil & Groundwater	The Soil & Groundwater Unit routinely conducts searches of its own files pertaining to waste disposal sites and environmental records, and provides responses based on the findings. The fee for this service is currently \$79.70 (inclusive of HST) per site. Please note that there may be other divisions or departments within the City you may wish to also contact for additional information. For instruments, spills, charges, orders or notices of violation, it is recommended that the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation & Parks be contacted for further information.
