
Expected Start Date: October 26, 2020 **Expected End Date:** November 25, 2020 *Timeline is subject to change.

This notice provides an update on the road reconstruction project on Lumbervale Avenue, St. Helens Avenue from College Street [North] to Lumbervale Avenue and College Street [North] from College Street to St Helens Avenue. Work on this project is currently on schedule.

We know this project has an impact to all businesses and residents in the area. We sympathize and appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, parking restrictions and other inconveniences.

- The City's contractor has finalized the road work.
- Tomorrow (Wednesday, November 25, 2020), City of Toronto Signs and Markings staff will install the new traffic / parking signage on Lumbervale Avenue, St Helens Avenue and College Street [North]. Once the signage is installed, these streets will open to all traffic.
- Please follow the new traffic rules once they are in place.

WORK STATUS TO DATE

The City's contractor has:

- Dug up the road surface
- Re-aligned maintenance holes and catch basins
- Repaired curbs, gutters and driveways
- Repaved the road surface
- Restored all areas affected by construction

REMAINING WORK

After the road reconstruction work is completed, City crews will:

- Install new traffic direction signage and stop signs to be completed by City Signs and Markings staff once road work is completed (Wednesday, November 25, 2020).
- Close the segment of St Helens Avenue from College Street to College Street [North] by installing pavement markings, bollards and stones
