**1. Mehdi Jafari Berenji** (Report No. 7453)

Applicant for the Renewal of Non-Motorized Refreshment Vehicle Owner's Licence Nos. V27-4710742, V27-4710745, V27-4863488, Plate Nos. 1631, 1632 and 650

AND

Holder of Non-Motorized Refreshment Vehicle Owner's Licence No. V27-4989156, Plate No. 1700

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, originally signed on December 9, 2020, as follows:

"Non-Motorized Refreshment Vehicle Licence's will be issued, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the licences may be cancelled;
- (2) Upon being issued the Non-Motorized Refreshment Vehicle Licence's will be placed on probation for a period of TWO (2) years. Mehdi Jafari Berenji is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Mehdi Jafari Berenji and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Mehdi Jafari Berenji's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 545 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (3) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Mehdi Jafari Berenji or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and report no. 7453 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing".

**2. Desmond Lloyd Brooks (Report No. 7403)**

Applicant for the Renewal of Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence No. D01-4687755

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the request for adjournment to May 6, 2021, on consent.

The Tribunal further approved the following interim condition be placed on Mr. Brooks' Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence, on consent:
