### **Combined Sewer Relining at Cliffside Ravine Park**

#### Contract: 20ECS-LU-08SU Start Date: March 2021 End Date: December 2021 \*Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto plans to reline the combined sewer at Cliffside Ravine Park. For public safety, access to the park and trail will be closed and fenced-off during the construction project.


The combined sewer is an underground pipe designed to collect sanitary water, stormwater and melting snow. The part you own is from your house to the end of your property, the part the City owns is from the end of your property to the sewer.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2020 Capital Works Program to renew our aging infrastructure, improve water distribution and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer back-ups.

#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO

#### WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
- Work in the boulevard in front of homes and commercial properties is expected. This work
  includes removing and replacing driveways, municipal sidewalks and grassed boulevards, where
  necessary.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

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## **Pre-Construction Notice**

Ŀ	<b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the <b>Field Ambassador</b> to arrange for access during the construction period.
	Access to Your Home: The City-hired contractor may need access to the interior and exterior of your home to complete a pre-construction survey. Affected properties will receive a pre-construction survey request to schedule a time to complete the survey.
<b>N</b>	Important information for owners of sprinkler systems / heated driveways and private landscaping features. Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard) to avoid damage.
<u>aa aa</u> Aa aa	This includes items such as landscaping (plants and pavers), decorative objects, sprinkler systems or heated driveways. If you have a sprinkler system or heated driveway, please contact the <b>Field Ambassador</b> listed below.
