As indicated by Mayor Tory, the City is seeking clarity on a number of fronts, including the details with respect to enforcement of the regulations by our coordinated enforcement team.

As you know, our coordinated enforcement team includes Toronto police, City by-law enforcement officers and Toronto public health inspectors.

As soon as we have clarity from the Province on these issues, we will communicate clearly as to how our coordinated enforcement team will respond to and enforce these new Provincial orders.

I want to thank City staff, including all of those who are tasked with enforcing provincial orders, for all the work they do each day.

This is complicated and challenging work, but also important work that helps to protect public health and safety.

The City's website will be updated as soon as we receive clarity on the application of the orders announced by the Province yesterday.
