North York Storm Trunk Sewer Rehabilitation in the Ravine North of Gulliver Road

Contract: 19ECS-LU-03TT

Start Date: May 2020 End Date: November 2021

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the North York Storm Trunk Sewer located along the ravine area north of Gulliver Road, from Keele Street to the outfall into the Black Creek, west of Culford Road/Pitkin Court (see map on page 2).

The trunk storm sewer is a large underground pipe designed to collect stormwater and melting snow and release it into a nearby creek or river.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2021 Capital Works Program to renew the City's aging sewer infrastructure and will extend the service life of these trunk sewer sections approximately 50 years.

UPCOMING NIGHT WORK

In an effort to complete the construction on time, the contractor will be required to perform occasional night work.

Night shift work will not consist of any excavations or destructive activities. Most of the work will be performed underground. New panels will be lowered into temporary shafts and installed throughout the existing storm trunk sewer. Once panels are dropped in the trunk sewer, minimum noise from the installation tasks is anticipated from the surface.

Work will take place according to the contractor's construction schedule. Night work may be continuous for a couple weeks depending on the construction phase. The night shift will commence the week of January 18, 2021 until January 29, 2021. The working shift will be from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

IMPACTS

Potential light and noise may impact a few homes (backyards) along Pitkin and Parson Courts.

The work area will be illuminated with floodlights. Floodlights will be directed at the work area near the drop shaft for the safety of workers.

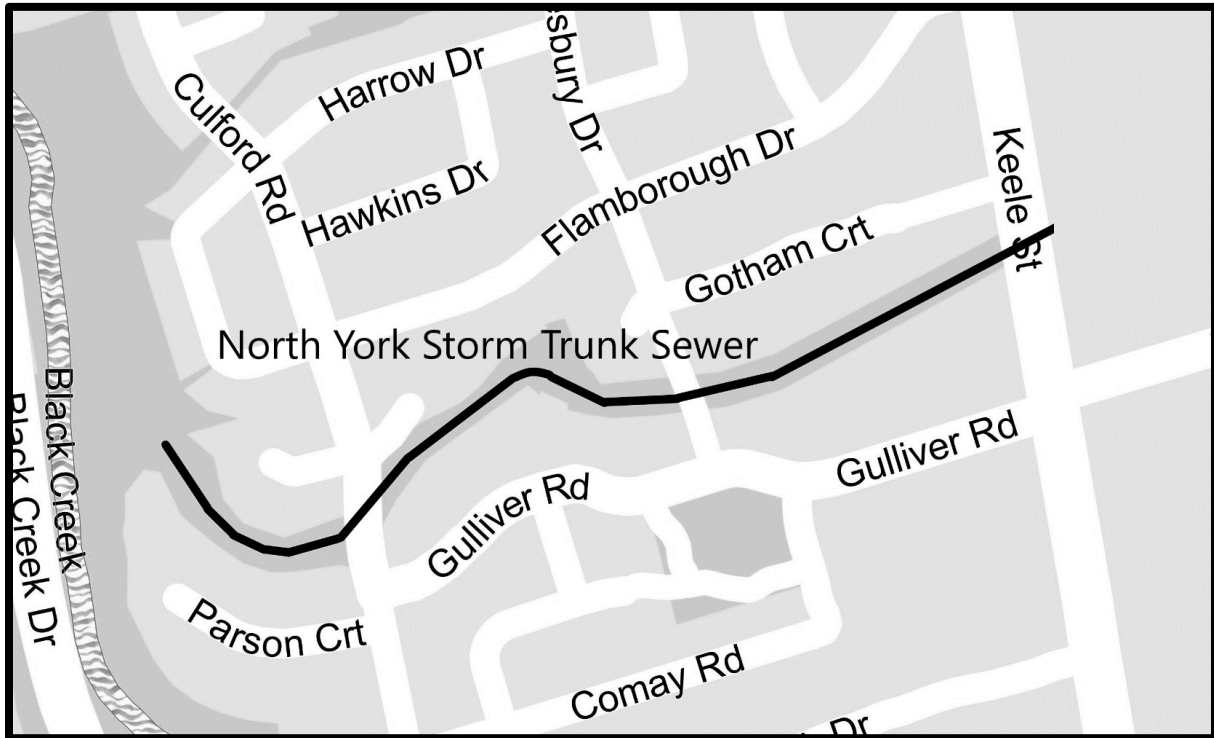
The work activities will generate noise at night. Some construction activities will generate more noise than others. The City will make efforts to reduce the noise. We appreciate your patience.
