

**BLIND-LOW VISION PROGRAM – SERVICE TARGETS**  
**APRIL 1, 2021 – March 31, 2022**

- Average age of children at referral will be less than 24 months.
- Average wait time from referral to first intervention will be less than 12 weeks.
- Infants and preschool children who are blind or have low vision, eligible for the BLVEI Program, will have:
  - ✓ an identified case coordinator
  - ✓ a Family Service Plan (FSP): updated through progress measurement and outcomes assessment every 6 months
  - ✓ a Determining Service Level Tool (DSL): updated every 6 months prior to completion of the Family Service Plan. Results of DSL are recorded, submitted to Early Abilities via the Toronto BLV Tracking Form –ECVC and retained
  - ✓ a Functional Sensory Assessment (FSA) Report: updated at specific intervals as indicated in the Determining Levels of Service Guidelines
- 100% of children who are discharged for the reasons “attending JK”, “attending SK” and “attending Grade 1” will receive transition to school plans
- Regional BLV program and service providers will participate in integrated team case coordination and community planning for BLV children
