Dufferin Street at Dupont Street Bridge Rehabilitation


Contract: 21ECS-TI-03BE Start Date: May 2021 End Date: December 2021 *Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the Dufferin Street bridge under the Canadian Pacific Railway (CP Rail) CP Rail at Dupont Street. This work will ensure that these bridges meet today's standards and remain safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2021 Capital Works Program.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
