## Don River Boulevard Bridge Superstructure Replacement over West Don River

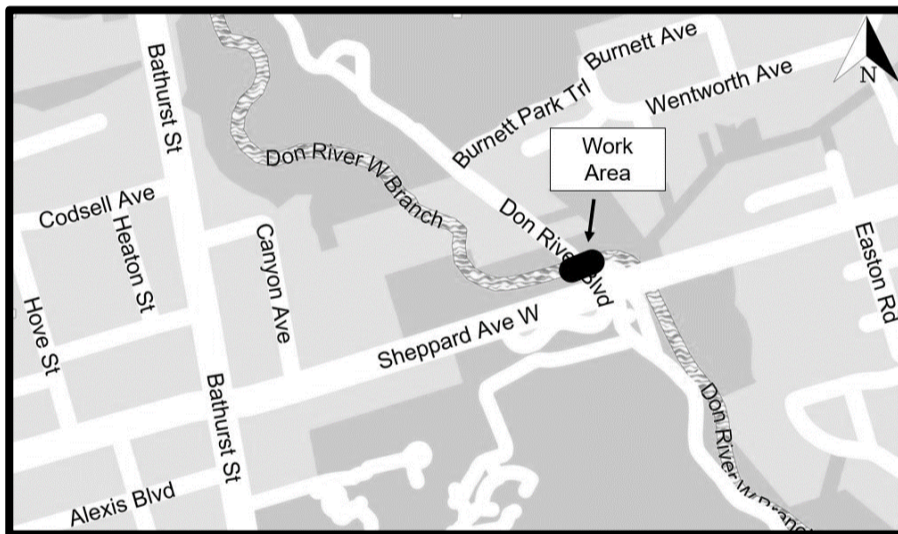
**Contract: 21ECS-TI-01BE**

The City of Toronto is planning to replace the superstructure of the Don River Boulevard Bridge over West Don River. The work will involve replacing the bridge deck and girders and repairing the bridge abutments. The railings will also be replaced to current City standards. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today’s standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2021 Capital Works Program.

### WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
