Bridge Rehabilitation Islington Avenue over Metrolinx Rail

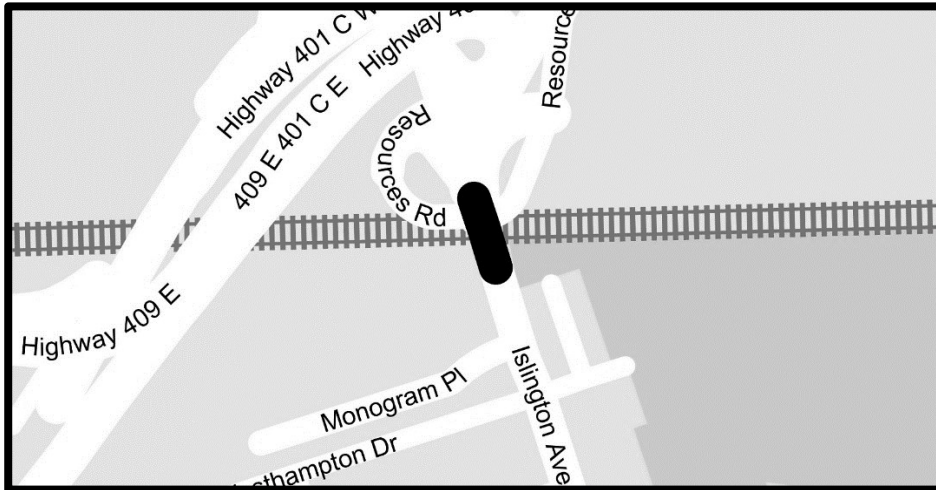

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the Islington Avenue bridge over Metrolinx rail starting in Spring 2021. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2021 Capital Works Program.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.

	Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the Field Ambassador to arrange for access during the construction period.
	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 11 p.m., Monday to Friday, and from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on weekends. Additionally, due to Metrolinx occupancy restrictions and daytime train schedule, there will be a period of time where the work will need to be completed overnight. Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the overnight work hours.
