Bridge Rehabilitation Rexdale Boulevard over Jockey Club Road

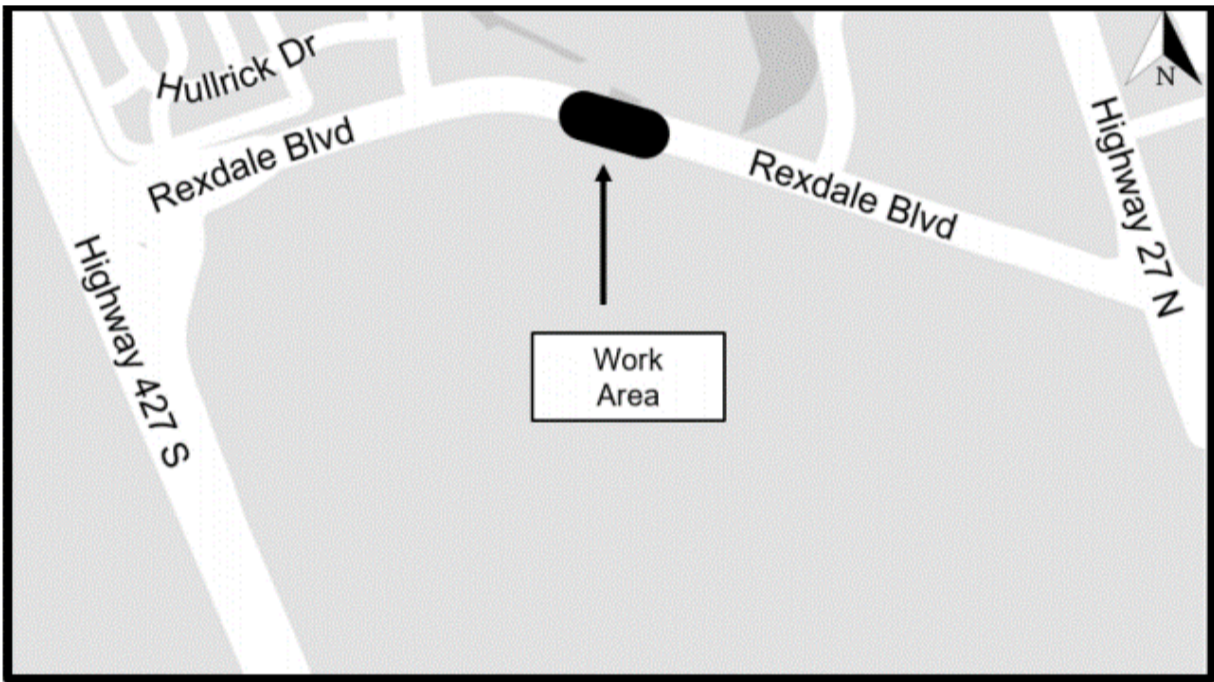

The City of Toronto will rehabilitate the Rexdale Boulevard over Jockey Club Road Bridge. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2019-2021 Capital Works Program.

WORK DETAILS






The City's contractor will:

- Repair and refurbish the existing Rexdale Boulevard Bridge over Jockey Club Road
- Reconstruct the concrete parapet walls, railings and approach slabs
- Patch repair the concrete deck and sidewalks, and the substructure's piers, abutments, and adjacent retaining walls
- Replace bridge bearings
- Replace the asphalt surface and waterproofing
- Improve bridge approaches and drainage

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise, and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>

	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Sidewalk access over Rexdale Boulevard Bridge will remain open at all time. Temporary signage will direct pedestrians to safely cross the bridge</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>Traffic on Rexdale Boulevard will be reduced to two lanes in each direction. Traffic on Jockey Club Road will be reduced to one lane in each direction.</p>
	<p>Physical Distancing: There are times when contractors need to communicate with residents about what is happening nearby. This could be about pre-construction inspections, and site restoration work (landscaping, installing pavers etc.). Contractor's staff will be identifiable by their high-visibility clothing and will maintain physical distancing.</p>
	<p>Site Safety: Workers on site are responsible for the work assigned to them. If you have construction questions or an issue on site – ask to be directed to the site inspector. If the site inspector is unavailable, contact the person listed at the end of this notice.</p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).</p>
