### Tree Removal and Site Clearing for the Richview Reservoir & Pumping Station Rehabilitation

Contract: 19ECS-MI-02WA Start Date: May 5, 2021 End Date: May 25, 2021 \*Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto will start rehabilitating the Richview Pumping Station and Reservoir located in Richview Park. This work will include waterproofing the reservoir roof, structural rehabilitation, and building new Standby Power to the facility.


Ahead of this construction work, trees located within the worksite will be cleared starting May 5, 2021 and require three to five weeks to complete. Residents will continue to be able to access this park until a construction notice is provided in the spring.

#### WORK DETAILS

Work will include:

- Removal of trees located on top of the reservoir, and surrounding areas slopes (see map)
- Installation of Tree Protection Zones





#### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on Saturdays as required. Email updates will be provided if extended hours are required.
	<ul> <li>Tree Removal: In order to complete this work, trees located on top of the reservoir and around the Pumping Station and Valve House will need to be removed:</li> <li>387 trees are planned to be removed,</li> <li>34 trees to be preserved (Tree Protection Zones)</li> <li>18 trees will be monitored for minimal injury.</li> <li>About 92 new trees and 385 shrubs will be replanted upon the completion of the Richview Pumping Station and Reservoir Rehabilitation project.</li> </ul>
